NewCity Madisonville-Hopkins County Frequently Asked Questions

1. **What is NewCity Madisonville-Hopkins County?** NewCity Madisonville-Hopkins County is a four month, citizen-driven effort to improve the quality of life and stimulate community and economic development for Madisonville and Hopkins County. The process is transparent and inclusive to all community residents.
2. **Who hired the NewCities Institute?** Partners for NewCity Madisonville-Hopkins County include the City of Madisonville, Hopkins County Fiscal Court, Trover Health System, and the Madisonville-Hopkins County Chamber of Commerce.
3. **What areas will be discussed?** Any of the following areas are open to discussion (but not limited to): economic development, entrepreneurship, community efficiency, planning and development, regional cooperation, environmental protection, greenspace, transportation, educational relationships, downtown, and heritage preservation.
4. **If I get involved, how much time will it take?** We encourage people to give as much, or as little, time as they have to give. These events are the most critical: 1) the community listening sessions on September 18th and 20th - see event calendar for times and locations-, 2) the Community Kickoff event on Saturday, September 22nd at , and 3) the Community-Building Charette on Saturday, September 22nd immediately following the Kickoff Rally that will end around 2:00 p.m. After that, how much time you choose to spend is up to you.
